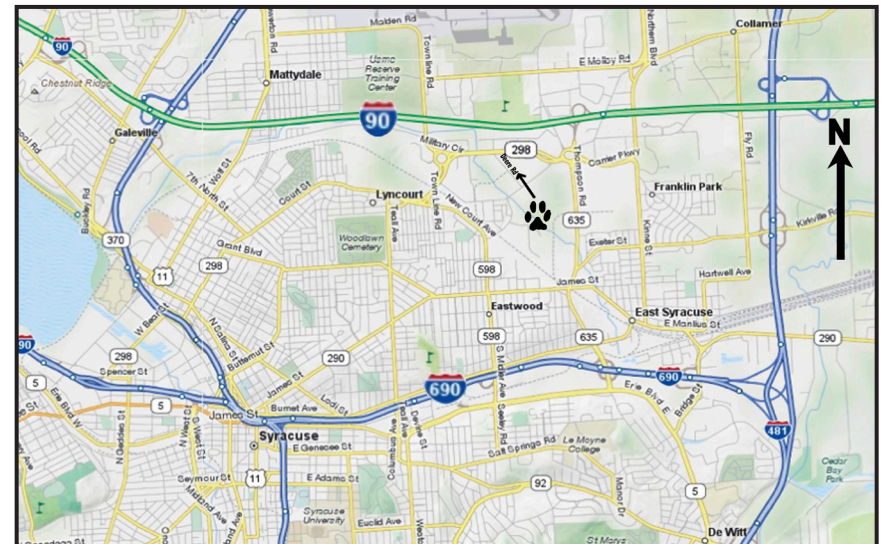
SHOW SITE CONVENIENT TO N.Y.S. THRUWAY EXIT 35

RALLY TRANSFERS/MOVE UPS - Rally transfers/move-ups may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. The request for a rally transfer or move up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

RIBBON PRIZES

A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, Obedience/Rally trial or Tracking test. This fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one obedience/rally class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on each entry.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
