*Children of any age are eligible to handle a dog in a Barn Hunt Trials as long as they can control the animal before, during, and after the hunt. However, the parent or guardian must remain on the premises at all times with any child under the age of 16.

*It is expressly understood that participants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s). Any participant whose dog(s) create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the Event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Genesee Valley Kennel Club Inc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by participants or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property. Genesee Valley Kennel Club Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog(s) on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Genesee Valley Kennel Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

Entry Forms: There are two ways to complete an entry form. An entry form may be completed using the "Create Entry" form on the Barn Hunt website. After completing

this form, it must be printed, signed and mailed to the Trial Secretary. Alternatively, the entry form attached to this premium must be completed, signed and mailed to the Trial Secretary. Entries must be postmarked by July 25th. Late fees apply. **No Day of Trial entries will be accepted.**

Refunds: No refunds will be issued **after the July 25th closing date except as otherwise indicated.**

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season (BIS) **MAY** compete in this event. They will run at the end of each class. BIS must wear pants at all times when not being walked on the grounds. Owners of BIS should seek out one of the Committee members upon arrival so that you can be directed to the designated parking and walking area. Advance notice to the secretary is greatly appreciated if you will be bringing a BIS! Failure to notify the secretary and fellow competitors will result in dismissal from the show grounds.

Camping: There is very limited self-sufficient camping on the grounds (NO hook ups). Please contact the Trial Chair before sending in your entry if you wish to camp to be sure there is space.

Parking: This trial takes place at a personal residence; please park in designated areas only.

Crating: All crating will be outside. Please ensure your dog's comfort in the event of hot weather by providing water, fans, shade screens, etc. All dogs must be crated or on a leash at all times except when in the ring.

Volunteers: We rely on our fantastic volunteers to help our trials run smoothly. Most jobs require little training and it's a great opportunity to learn more about the sport and the rules. Please let any member of our Trial Committee know if you would like to help. A sign-up sheet for volunteers will be available at check in. Many thanks!

Blinds: Outdoors, covered

Loud/Disruptive dogs: Please keep dog barking to a minimum so as not to disturb the working dogs.

Collars and Leashes: Per BHA rules, electronic collars, bark collars, muzzles and head halters are not allowed anywhere on the trial grounds. All other collar, lead, and harness types are allowed to be used on Trial grounds. Covered pinch/prong collars with a quick release snap/buckle are allowed. Dogs cannot be brought to the blind or the ring on flexi-leads. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses/slip-leads which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring.

Additional Information:

*Exhibitors not attending the General/Judge’s briefing will still be held responsible for knowing the information given in these briefings.

*This trial takes place at a personal residence. Please be considerate about picking up after your dogs and leaving the grounds as you found them. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement, per BHA Regulations.

DIRECTIONS to 2019 Risser Road Canandaigua, NY 14424

From the West on Thruway – take Exit 44 (Canandaigua). Follow Route 332 to Route 96. Turn left onto Route 96. Take your 3rd right onto Payne Road. Cross 2 intersections and Payne Road becomes Risser Road. Event location will be on your left. Driveway is flanked by 2 large columns of horse shoes.

From the East on Thruway – take Exit 43 (Manchester). Turn right onto Route 21. Turn Right onto Route 96. Take your 5th left onto Payne Road. Cross 2 intersections and Payne Road becomes Risser Road. Event location will be on your left. Driveway is flanked by 2 large columns of horse shoes.

From the North – take Route 21 South. Turn Right onto Route 96. Take your 5th left onto Payne Road. Cross 2 intersections and Payne Road becomes Risser Road.

Event location will be on your left. Driveway is flanked by 2 large columns of horseshoes.

From the South – take Main Street/332 North through Canandaigua. Turn right onto North Street. Stay straight onto Macedon Road. Make slight left onto Risser Road. Event location will be on your right. Driveway is flanked by 2 large columns of horseshoes.

PLEASE bring personal cleaning supplies, a pen or pencil, food and water for yourself and your dog, and a mask or face shield. Gloves are optional.

Entries/checks will be held until the week of the trial (8/1) or until the trial committee thinks that it’s safe that the event is likely to occur. We will be flexible with refunds and waitlists.

Please be flexible with judge changes, length of class times, class changes and ring locations as they are subject to change while we implement our new processes.

Please plan accordingly to limit the length of time you are at the trial.

Everyone must wear a mask or face shield at all times except when the distance between yourself and others exceeds 10 feet. You must sign the UPDATED COVID-19 waiver required by Barn Hunt Association, LLC and mail or email it before entering the trial grounds.
